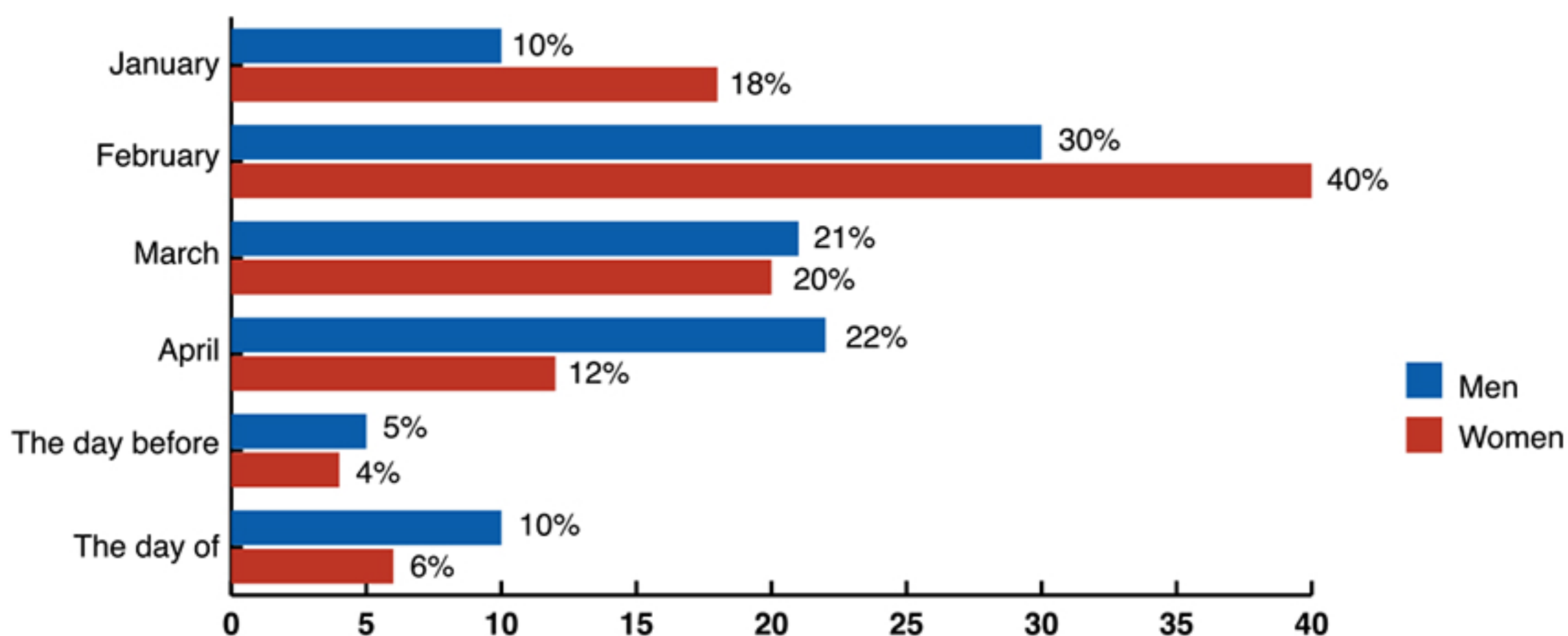


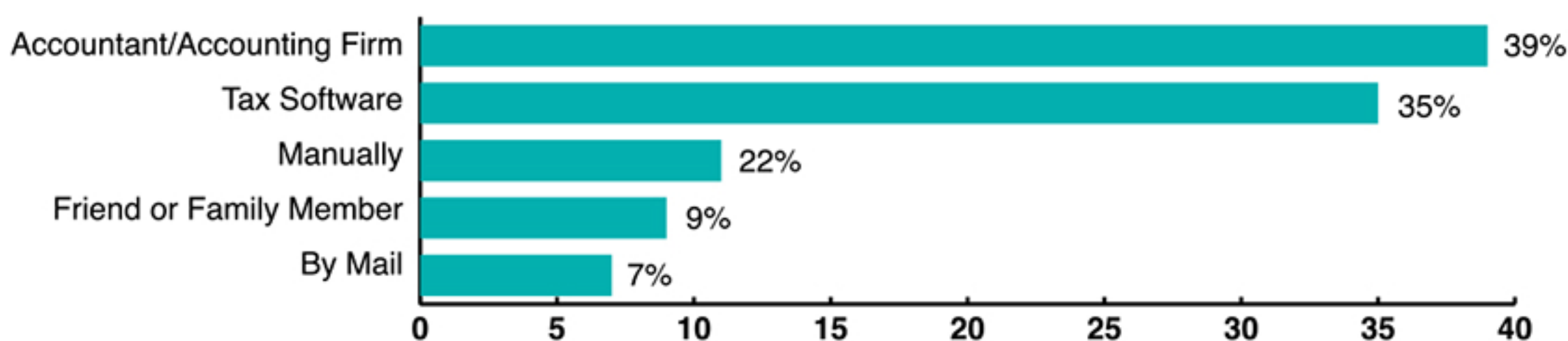
2018 TAX SEASON SURVEY

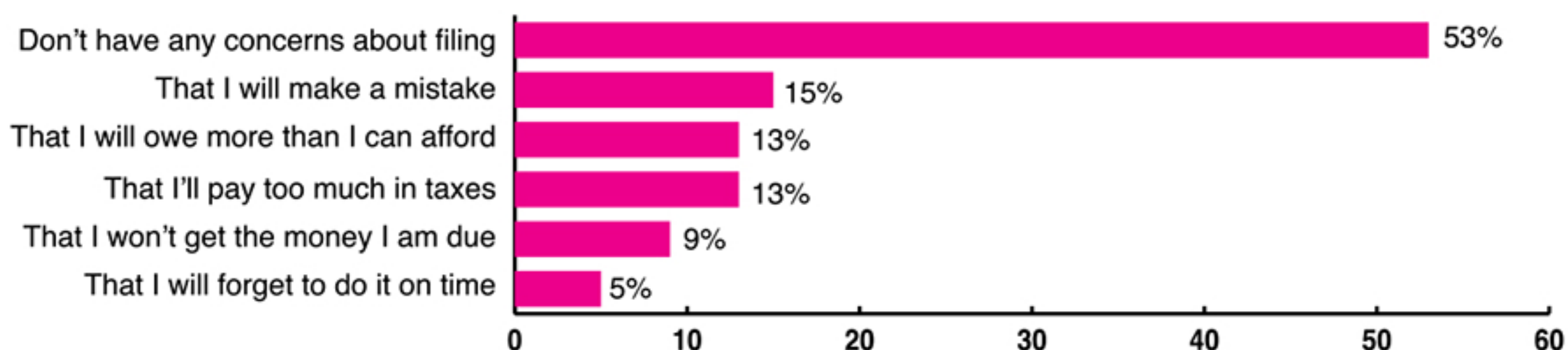
WHEN DO YOU FILE YOUR TAXES?



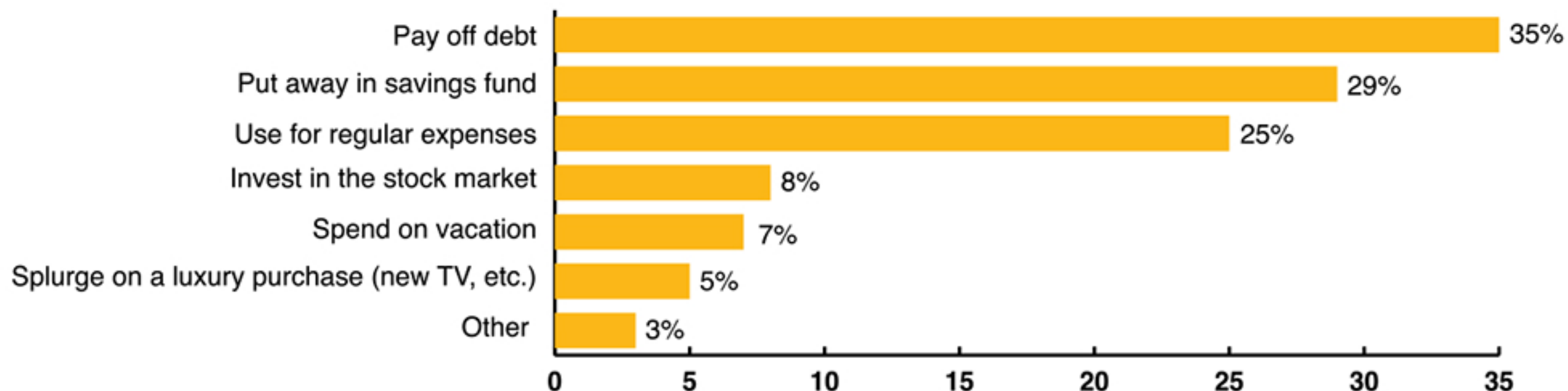
HOW DO YOU FILE YOUR TAXES?
