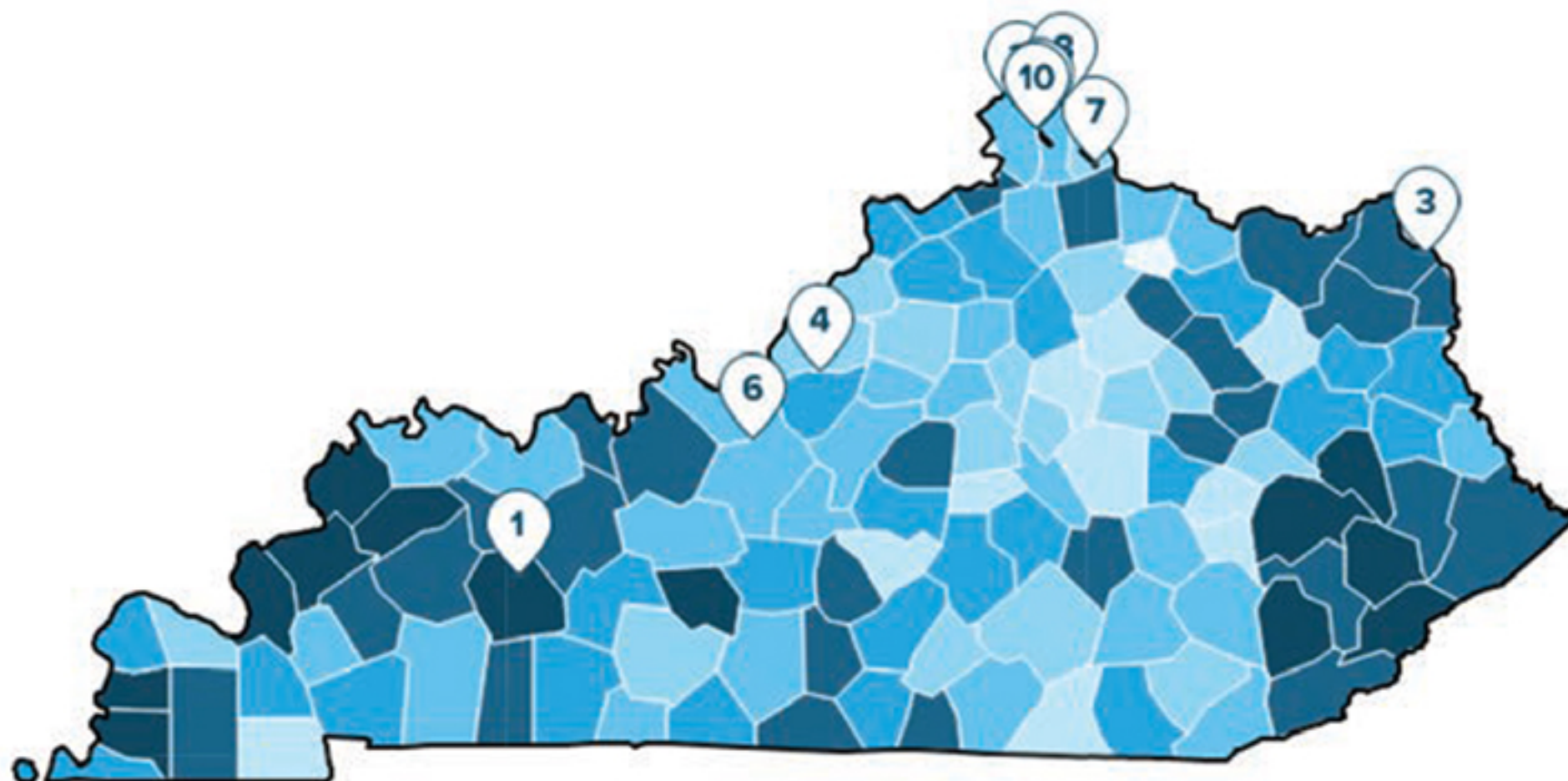


## THE MOST AFFORDABLE PLACES TO LIVE IN KENTUCKY
