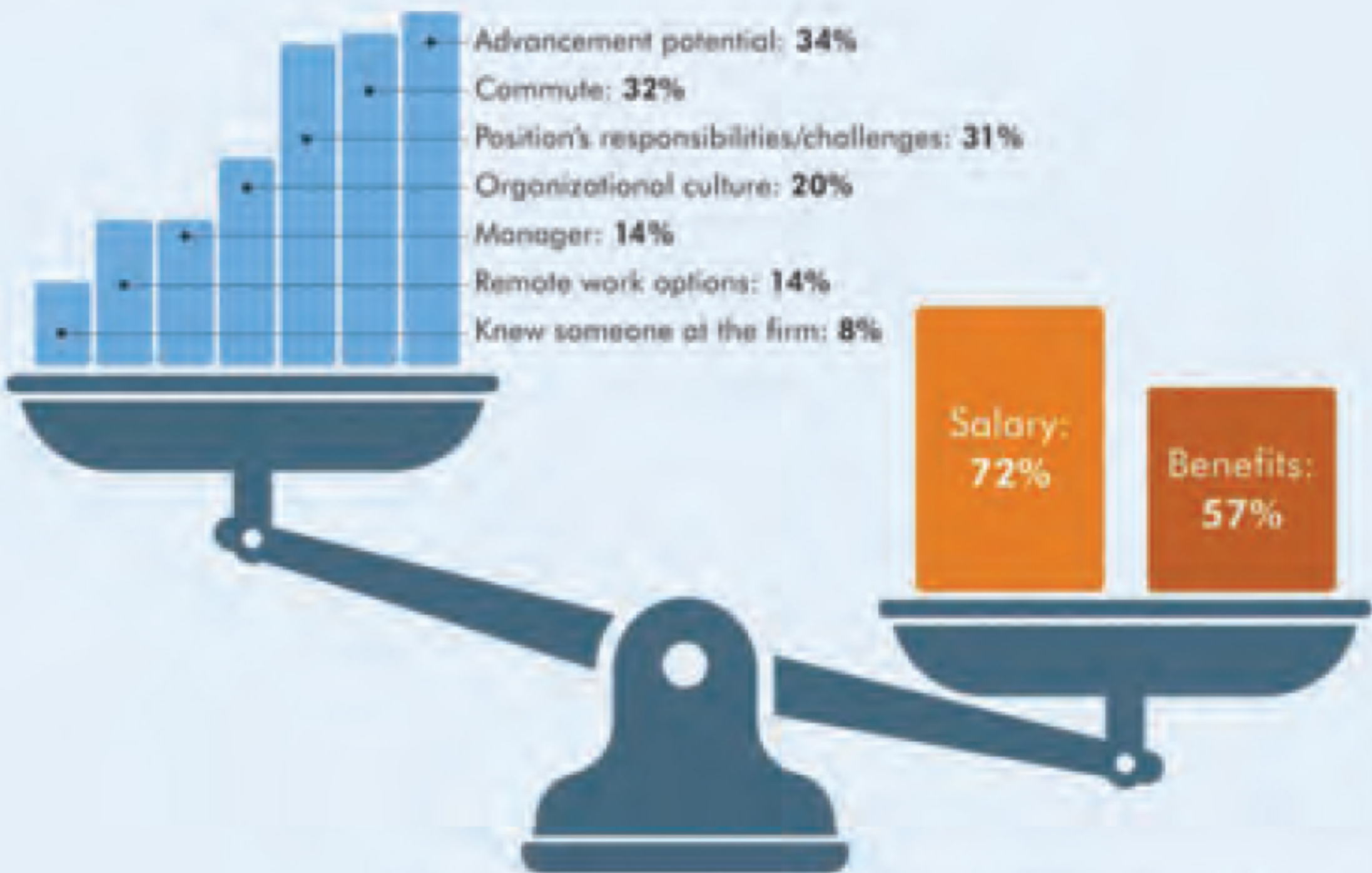


Percentage of job seekers who have received two or more job offers simultaneously
