How do I sign up?

First take an online assessment to determine eligibility at www. walgreens.com/coronavirus and, if qualified, you will be directed to select a location and an appointment time.

Where is the testing site?

Drive-thru testing will be conducted by appointment only in select locations in our parking lots.

How is the test administered?

The test is conducted with a self-administered nasal swab with directions by Walgreens pharmacists at our testing site.
